Credit Recovery Only

Basic credit recovery courses are designed to meet SUHSD graduation requirements and are offered as non- college prep classes.

A-G Grade Recovery

A-G grade recovery is designed to cover college prep curriculum via the use of online courses and resources provided by Shasta Union High School District (Edgenuity.com). Successful completion of a course with a grade of "C" or better will keep a student on-track for completing the University of California and California State University A-G course requirements and remain eligible for admission to UC and CSU schools. Not all A-G courses are available through SUHSD, if a student needs to make-up courses not offered by Shasta Union High School District, please contact your counselor for other available options.

The A-G curriculum requirements are standards set by both the University of California (UC) and the California State University (CSU) systems for admission. It must be noted, that the A-G requirements are different than the SUHSD graduation requirements, please check school website for graduation requirements. A student cannot receive a grade of "D" or "F" in any of the A-G classes as listed below:

A	HISTORY-SOCIAL SCIENCE	2 years required	
B	ENGLISH	4 years required	
C	MATHEMATICS	3 years required (including CP Math 1, 2, & 3),	4 years
D	LABORATORY SCIENCE	2 years (<i>college prep science including or integrating topics in two of these three subjects: biology, chemistry of physics.</i>)	3 years
E	FOREIGN LANGUAGE	2 years required in the same language; 3 years recommended	3 years
F	VISUAL & PERFORMING ARTS	1 year required	
G	COLLEGE PREP ELECTIVE	1 year required (Electives may be chosen from categories A-F)

<input type="checkbox"/>	Participation in the course is voluntary- Enrollment priority will be given to 12 th grade and then a first come first serve basis for all other grades
<input type="checkbox"/>	All course work for the class must be completed by the official end date of the class (a calendar will be made available at the start of the class)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Students have until the 10 th school day from their start date of the class to drop the course It is the student's/ parent responsibility to notify their counselor that they are dropping
<input type="checkbox"/>	All students who are still enrolled after the 10 th day of the class will receive a grade and it will be posted on their transcript
