Sophomore Year

• October: PSAT for students enrolled in Honors Math 2 or higher.

• November: Pre-ACT

Junior Year

October: PSAT

• January-June: SAT and ACT

April-November: Retake test of preference (SAT or ACT)

Senior Year

- SAT or ACT Retakes- Most colleges accept November as the latest possible score, however there are a few that will accept December test scores.
- Check with each school to find out specific deadlines.

SAT Subject Area Tests

- Should be taken immediately following the school year the class is taken.
- Students may take three subject area tests at one sitting.
- Students may not take a subject area test and the general SAT on the same day.

Scores

- SAT- students may decide to send their scores directly to four universities at the time of registration. Additional scores can be sent later for a fee per university. Students have the option of Score Choice when scores are sent later.
- ACT- students may decide to send their scores directly to four universities at the time of registration. Additional scores can be sent later for a fee per university if requested by mail or the web.
- California State Universities will "split scores", meaning they will take the highest Math score from any sitting and take the highest critical reading score from any sitting.
- CSU Admission does not take into account writing on the SAT and ACT
- University of California <u>will not</u> "split scores". The U.C. system uses your highest complete sitting.
- UC Admission takes into account writing on the SAT and ACT
