

Concurrent Enrollment Instructions

- 1. Complete the online application at www.shastacollege.edu. Please make sure you have your social security number.
- 2. Obtain a gold Shasta College Concurrent Enrollment form from the SHS counseling center.
- 3. Request an unofficial transcript from the counseling office.
 - Shasta College will review your transcript for placement into classes.
 - **For 9th and 10th graders interested in English, please see your counselor for additional instructions.
- 4. Look up the available class times online via www.shastacollege.edu.
- click on > My Shasta>Course Offerings>Subject>Term: Summer, Fall, Spring
- click on >Submit and decide which on campus or online section you want to take

5. Costs for Shasta College classes

High school students are no longer required to pay tuition fees at Shasta College; however, they are required to pay a health/university fee of \$40.50. The parking permit fee is \$30. The cost of book(s) is up to the student/parent to pay for.

6. Fill out Concurrent Enrollment Form

Complete the college course information on the concurrent enrollment form. Obtain a parent signature on the concurrent enrollment form then take the form to your counselor and then to Mr. Perez and obtain their signatures. PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT NEITHER YOUR COUNSELOR NOR MR. PEREZ WILL SIGN THE CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT FORM UNTIL ALL THE INFORMATION IS COMPLETE!
