PARKING PERMITS

• **Juniors and Seniors**: In order to be officially entered into the lottery, all of the following must apply and be confirmed. You are a full-time student at Shasta (4 classes or more) in good standing (no past due fees or parking fines), AND that you can provide paperwork that includes <u>copies</u> of a valid Driver's License or Learner's Permit, Vehicle Registration and Insurance, and signed Parking Contract. Previous parking violations or excessive student behavior demerits may restrict a student's ability to purchase a parking permit.

Follow these steps to sign up to be entered in the Parking Permit lottery:

- 1 Sign up online at **WEBSITE**. You are required to enter all vehicle information and parking lot preferences. When this is completed, you will receive a confirmation email confirming our receipt of your application. **OR** You may also attend your scheduled Orientation time and fill out a Parking Lottery Request with Mrs. Price.
- 2 A copy of the following items need to be submitted before your application is complete.
 - A. Driver's license. (Seniors and Juniors who turn 16 by October 1, 2022 & have a Learner's Permit will be allowed to purchase a parking permit. The permit will be held until October 15, 2022. If proof of Driver's License cannot be shown by this date, the permit will be forfeited. Those students must still pay by August 16, 2022 to hold the permit.)
 - B. Please copy onto <u>one</u> page: Your current DMV Registration form, current proof of insurance card, and Driver's License.
 - C. Shasta High School Parking Contract form, signed by both student and parent.

These items can be submitted to the office through the following methods.

- 1. Scan copies of all paperwork and email it to sprice@suhsd.net, OR
- 2. Print copies of all paperwork and drop it off in the Main Office with Sarah Price. You may do this anytime up until the deadline for the Lottery sign up, which is Aug. 9, 2022
- 3 Confirm through your Aeries account that you have no Student Fees. You will receive an email to inform you of any fees that need to be cleared before you are officially entered into the Lottery. You must take care of all outstanding bills owed to the school before your application is approved to enter the lottery. Ex: Library fines, lost or damaged books or Chromebooks, athletic equipment, uniforms (band, athletic, cheerleading, etc.), parking tickets, NSF checks, etc.
- 4 The deadline to complete Steps 1 3 is Aug. 9, 2022. By that date, if you have not signed up, submitted the appropriate paperwork, OR you still have fees on your account, your application will be pulled out of the Lottery.

Payment and pick up of Parking Permit:

- A lottery will be held for the parking permits. Seniors have first priority and any remaining permits will be awarded to Juniors. Students who have their license will have priority over students who have their learner's permit. Only students that have completed all steps above will be entered.
- The results of the lottery for <u>all</u> students will be posted on Friday, August 12, 2022 near the Student Store. You will also receive an email confirming which parking lot you received in the lottery.
- There are 2 different ways to pay for your parking permit.
 - 1. Pay online on the school's web store at www.shastawolves.com. Bring a copy of your receipt to pick up your permit in the student store during the scheduled pick up time. This is the faster option.
 - 2. Pay with Mrs. Taylor in the Student Store during the scheduled pick up time.
- Permits are available for purchase in the Student Store during the following hours ONLY: from 1:00 pm 3:00 pm on the following dates: Fri. Aug. 12, Mon. Aug 15, or Tues Aug. 16, 2022. Permits will not be available for pick up at any other time during the day. All permits will need to be purchased and obtained by 3 pm on Tuesday, August 16, 2022 or they will be forfeited and the permit will go back into a 2nd lottery that will take place around September 10, 2022. If you choose to park in one of the permitted parking lots without displaying a permit on the first day of school, you may be cited and will held responsible for any citation given.
- We <u>will not</u> refund the difference in price to you at any time if you forget to bring proof of purchasing an ASB card. You will have to buy the permit at regular price. There will be no refunds after November 1, 2022.

- We sell "parking lot specific" permits. This means that you may only park in the lot for which your permit is valid. Students will be assured of a space in their designated lot. If there is no space available, students should report to the Main Office immediately. We will <u>only</u> sell parking permits for the number of spaces available in each lot. Students must decide in advance where they want to park and how much they are willing to pay. Students may want to refer to their class schedule when picking a lot. The parking lots are assigned a color designation and a price. Permits must be purchased in person to legally park in designated lots. Each driver may purchase only one permit. Permits may not be re-sold, loaned or gifted to another student. A portion of all revenue received will be used for campus improvements/student activities.
- *** Disclaimer: Due to construction, the potential for all parking (designated permitted parking and street parking) may be affected. SHS will do their best to supply designated overflow parking for permit holders.***
